## **Bulldog Athletic Booster Meeting Notes**

May 21, 2018 @ Ravenna High School 7:00pm

Call to Order: President Troy Johnson called meeting to order at exactly 7:00pm.

**Role/Welcome/Introductions:** none were needed as everyone had been to previous meetings and new everyone present. See attached list of attendance to the meeting.

<u>Approval of Minutes from April Meeting:</u> Motion made by Kris to approve the April minutes, Matt Parker seconded the motion. Motion passed.

**Agenda Review/Topics:** Moved Treasurer's report to after concession stand report and added nominations to New Business section.

#### **Committee Reports:**

Fundraising Committee: Kris Emery shared that Kubasiak 5K Run/Walk was a huge success. Overall, the event raised close to \$12,000. Total of 229 runners participated and a big thank you goes out to Matt Parker, Darrin Spoon and Annie Kubasiak for all their work with this project. Kris continued to share that BABR made around \$3,290 from the event, because it was decided by the committee before the race that BABR would help organize the event and split only the entry fee total. All the rest of the money donated and raised was given to the Kubasiak family to use for their Scholarship Fund. Looking to have a meeting to finalize everything for this year and plan for next year!!!

Golf Outing: Andrew Emery reported out that they currently have 10 teams signed up and the total teams available to sign up would be 25. Sign up soon because they are filling up fast. He handed out some flyers and some donation slips for people in attendance (attached a copy to these notes). Andrew continued to encourage Kyle to send flyers to the coaches to encourage their presence at this event, which Kyle has already done. "Smokin' Bro's BBQ will be providing the meat and other food items will be donated as well. Hole sponsor signs will need to be made this year and hopefully will not have to be purchased for future years to save on an additional expense. Deadline for Hole Sponsorship is July 7, 2018. Contact Jeff and Hailey Mabrito or Gary and Jill Nutt for more information. Flyer is attached to these notes and is also on the BABR website.

<u>Brick Fundraiser:</u> Matt Parker has investigated a program in which people or business' purchase a brick to line the walkway to the football stadium. Also, mentioned that these bricks could be placed near softball and baseball fields as well to accommodate people of different sports. All earnings from this fundraiser will go toward weight room equipment and restoration. Mr. Seth McCullough has offered his services if needed for installation of the bricks. More information to come.

**Spirit Store:** No Report currently.

<u>Concessions Report:</u> Everything is going well in the concession stand from Dustin Drummond. Track Invitational was a huge success. Hoping to finish out the baseball and softball season concessions strong and continue to find success when we host districts for baseball and softball. We are currently in transition from Coke products to Pepsi and from here forward, we will start stocking with Pepsi products when Coke products are sold out.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> We currently report \$24,377 in our account, pending audit. We have distributed some money to groups that have completed their obligations and submitted a request form. More forms are coming in

for requests, so things may change as the month progress'. Revenue statement is on the <u>website</u> and attached to these notes.

#### **Athletic Directors Report:**

- Kyle has been in contact with the Pepsi rep and handed us the Pepsi contract this evening.
- Kyle has the baseball and softball district schedule so look for that on the BABR website.
- Kyle mentioned that we will host the girls' basketball districts next year (winter season).
- Currently looking for a Girls Basketball and Volleyball coach. Posted internally for now, then will search outside district.
- Wrestling question was brought up and Kyle has not had the time to investigate the situation that exists with them hosting events and concessions.
- Kyle will address football liaison requests under Liaisons section.

#### **Liaisons Report:**

- o Chris Hansen spoke on behalf of the Cheer program and said within the next two weeks they will be talking to Kyle regarding a coach for sideline, competitive and youth football. Chris also mentioned that they will have things in place to host an event next year for cheer and put in the request form early enough to have a successful event.
- o Kyle Jawor presented a request for Coach Samuels for 7-7 gear for the summer. Coach Samuels presented information regarding cost of items through BSN in the amount of \$1708.00. Since all requirements were met for football concessions and attendance, Kris Emery made a motion to approve the purchase of the 7-7 gear for the football program. Matt Parker seconded the motion, motion carried.

### Old Business: None currently.

#### **New Business:**

- Money for training supplies for the year in the amount of \$1000 dollars. There was discussion where this money would come from and what about teams that don't participate in BABR but still use the athletic trainer's services and equipment. It was estimated that if we divided the cost among the participating programs at this time, it would be a minimum of \$80 to use the services. This number may change, but the BABR board will look into this cost. In the meantime, Kris Emery made a motion that the BABR take \$1000 off the top of our budget to cover the cost of the trainer supplies for the year. Hailey Mabrito seconded the motion, motion carried. This would become a yearly expense for the boosters, but we will discuss later, how to charge teams to use the training equipment that do not participate with BABR.
- Wi-Fi at the football concession stand. Kyle already had this installed and is asking for BABR to contribute to the cost in the amount of \$600. We have decided to table this for further discussion since we were not aware this was already purchased and not discussed.
- Tax Forms 990 Trustee Lynn Becklin completed these forms and have submitted a copy to the may notes.
- <u>Health Dept. License Renewal:</u> We were unaware that a bill had arrived at the high school and until Kyle was reminded by the Administrative Offices that this was overdue, we not only had to pay the \$76 renewal fee, but for each day overdue, the state charges \$10. So, we had \$90 in overdue payment. This will not happen again next year and will make note to pay this by April of each year. Also, we will make sure the bill is mailed to the address on the account, Lynn Becklin's address.

Public Comment: Only 1 community member spoke up and requested that Lynn Becklin and Matt Parker be removed from the BABR siting a conflict of interest with the Ravenna Youth Football Program. The complaint was made that on Facebook, the Ravenna Youth Football program was starting their own cheer club which conflicts with the current cheerleading board bylaws. The community member

stated that after going to the Ravenna Youth Football Program website, she noted that Matt Parker and Lynn Becklin were still listed as members of that board and should be removed from the BABR board due to conflict of interest. After finished speaking, Lynn Becklin clarified to this community member that she had resigned from the RYFC in November of last year and didn't appreciate the accusation made. At this point, the BABR board decided to investigate the situation and not take Facebook as a reliable resource of information. Dustin Drummond will be looking into this situation and contacting the appropriate people to clear up any misunderstanding.

• **Nominations:** It was at this point in the night that we asked everyone present, including current board members to nominate 7 people to be on the ballot for next month's voting process for the BABR board members for the next 2 years. Ballots were collected and will be counted after the meeting with two community members as witness to the nomination process.

### Adjournment: Meeting adjourned at 8:10pm.
